**PROPOSED ORDER PERMITTING DEFENSE COUNSEL TO ACCESS
DEFENDANT IN CUSTODY AND BRING LAPTOP OR OTHER MATERIALS FOR
DEFENDANT'S REVIEW**

As this case involves voluminous amounts of electronic discovery, including but not limited to audio and video recordings, it is essential that counsel for Defendant be permitted to review such electronic discovery materials with Defendant.
